



KEARNY CARES SMALL BUSINESS GRANT PROGRAM – How Can the Kearny Small Business COVID-19 Relief Program Help Your Business?

Mayor Alberto G. Santos and the Kearny Town Council in partnership with Hudson County Executive Thomas A. DeGise, the Hudson County Board of Chosen Freeholders and with support from Valley National Bank, are pleased to announce Kearny's Small Business Relief Program which offers grants up to \$20,000 to help businesses with no more than 25 fulltime employees (or their part-time equivalent) affected by the COVID-19 Pandemic.

Grants may be used for a range of COVID-19 Pandemic costs resulting from closure, partial closure, or interruption of your small business. Grants may be used to pay for eligible expenses incurred or anticipated to be incurred from March 15, 2020 through August 31, 2020.

To apply for a Grant, you must certify your business's registration with the State Division of Taxation and provide documentation of the expenses to be addressed by your grant. Grants will be paid in full at the time of approval. Any funds improperly used or fraudulently obtained will be required to be returned with interest.
